Appointment of WHNA Traffic Coordinator

The board has appointed Woodland Hills resident Quimin Lam as the new WHNA Traffic Coordinator. Webmaster Jesse will arrange for a new email address, traffic@woodlandhillsatlanta.org.

Traffic issues Quimin will address:

- 1 – The stop sign at Woodland Hills Drive, Woodland Hills Ave, and Palafox. The board is concerned that several residents have received unfair tickets at this stop sign. There is no clear indication of where in the intersection you are supposed to stop at. The board would like a line painted on the road to clarify the confusing intersection.
- 2 – Missing/vandalized traffic signs around the neighborhood.
- 3 – Possible speed bumps along Woodland Hills.

Bylaws

The board needs to arrange a meeting prior to the Quarterly General Assembly meeting on October 29th strictly to discuss major points of the bylaws.

- 3- Neighborhood entrance signs – to be developed by Brad Grulke and Nathan Martin. We need 5 signs: one on each side of Shepherds, one on Briar Vista Terr, one on Woodland Hills Ave, and one on Olgilve.
